

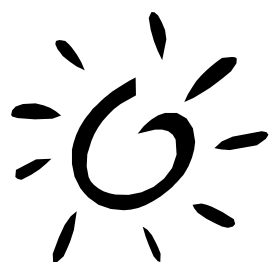
Camp Agapé

The Summer Staff and I are looking forward to your arrival. If you should have any questions before or during your stay at Agapé, please call the Camping Office at (724) 356-2308.

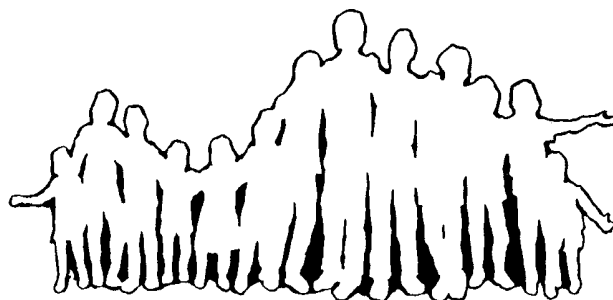
Please know that we are praying for you and your family as part of our preparation for the summer.

What To Bring To Camp

- Bible
- Health Form
- Medications (if needed)
- Sleeping Bag (or sheets & blankets)
- Pillow (if desired)
- Flashlight & Extra Batteries
- Toothbrush & Toothpaste
- Soap & Shampoo
- Deodorant
- Towels
- Sturdy** Shoes (2 or more pairs)
- Jacket
- Swimming Suit
- Warm Pants
- Shorts
- Shirts
- Socks
- Underwear
- Bug Spray
- Sunscreen
- Backpack
- Flip-Flops (for POOL USE ONLY!!!)



Keep In Mind When Packing

It can be cold in the evenings and early mornings at Camp Agapé. Be sure to bring along enough warm clothing.



It's a really good idea to put your name or initials on everything you bring to camp. That way, if you lose something, it can be easily returned when found.

What To Leave At Home

Campers are **not** allowed to bring cell phones to camp!

It is strongly recommended that you **do not** bring iPods, cell phones, stereos, walk-mans, computer games/toys, money or other valuables to camp. Camp Agapé is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Do not bring any food or snacks to camp. Ample meals and snacks will be provided. Any snacks that you bring must be given to camp staff upon arrival to be shared with ALL campers at an appropriate time. Food in cabins and tents is forbidden because it WILL attract unwanted animals.

Phone Calls

Campers may **not** bring cell phones. They are strongly discouraged from making telephone calls. In an event that a call home is necessary, a camper will have to use a phone card or make a collect call. There is a long distance block on all phones at Camp Agapé. Calls from the camp to Pittsburgh are long distance. Parents are also discouraged from calling to speak with campers. If absolutely necessary, please call:

Insurance

Your own health and accident insurance must provide the primary coverage. Camp Agapé provides only secondary coverage to camp users. Please include the requested information about your insurance carrier on each Health Form. We will make every effort to contact parents (or other designated persons) promptly in the event of serious accident or illness.

Reminders

Please bring along the Health Form (completed on **ALL** sides) and any remaining balance due to registration when you arrive at camp.

The Health Form must be completed & signed for participation in the camp program. The back page should be completed & signed by a Licensed Medical Professional. A physical exam is required within 24 months of camp attendance.
